Play the video on page 4. The speaker says that people have struggled to make a living for thousands of years. Why is is hard to make a living?

Harsh weather, short growing season, lack of communications, limited space.

Part 3

In the same video.

What do most people make a living from today? Farming or tourism.

Answer...... Tourism

Part 4

In the same video: trains have to go up and down very steep slopes. What do they use to help?

Answer.....

Teeth set into the track.

What are the roads over the passes like?.

Answer They have many hairpin bends/switchbacks and are very steep and narrow.

Turn to pages 6-7
What is the pattern of mountains over the Earth's surface.
Answer They occur in long lines
Write down four mountain chains
Answer Himalayas, Andes, Rockies, Alps, Great Dividing Range
Part 6
Now turn to pages 8 and 9.
The mountains are caused by something happening inside the Earth. Write a short description of what causes mountain chains to be pushed up and their rocks folded.
Answer  Moving molten material below the crust drags Earth's plates into one another where the edges get buckled to make mountain chains.
