What is a drainage basin, also called a river basin?

Where do you find most cultivated fields?
Answer On or near to the floodplain where soils are more fertile and slopes not too steep.
Where do we find a reservoir?
Answer In uplands where you can dam rives most easily. The deep valleys mean you store a lot of water without using up much land.
Where are many towns and cities built?
Answer Where rivers join and where bridges can be built.
What are steeper valley sides used for?
Answer Mainly pasture.
