Is a lake made by a river?
Answer The deep bowl of a lake is not made by a river. Many are due to glaciers in the past. What the river does is to fill up the bowl with sand and silt, so eventually all lakes will fill in.

Answer A delta. The river carries sand, silt and clay because it is fast-flowing. In the still waters of a lake or sea these materials settle out to make a delta.
