The River Book

In this segment we ask students to do a project on one of the rivers below. Each one has a dedicated book in Curriculum Visions.

Amazon Mississippi Nile

Use the search on Curriculum Visions (only) to find the main book on the river of your choice.

Students are asked: Suppose you were a tourist going from the source to the mouth of your river. Using the book as a source, write a diary of the changes you see as you make your journey.

Each answer will be unique.

This is a particularly good project for learning how to summarise in English.

Students should write what they want (a summary in itself) and then be asked to halve it, making a summary of a summary.

This should be repeated until they come to just one line (effectively a tweet)

Ask students to explain why they kept some things and got rid of others at each stage.
