Why do different types of animals have different types of teeth?

Answer.....

Their teeth help them to eat food. So, a plant eater will have mostly teeth that grind food, a meat eater will have mostly teeth that tear and cut food, and an animal that eats meat and plants will have all three types of teeth.

Go to pages 22-23. Why can't pet dogs, cats and hamsters eat human food?

Answer.....

Because wild dogs and cats eat meat, so they should mostly eat meat. Hamsters can only eat vegetables and can't eat any meat. Some human foods can harm them.
