In this segment, we are going to think about some different habitats.

You will need to go to pages 12-13 of the book.

Draw a picture of a habitat for an earthworm, a mole, or a springtail. Label the different parts of it and explain why it is a good habitat for the worm.

Answers will vary.....

The drawings should show the part of the soil where the animal lives and explain that the animal can find food and shelter in that part of the soil.

Go to pages 14-15

Design an experiment to see what animals live in the branches of a tree or shrub. If your teacher agrees, try out your experiment. Write about what you found. If you do not find any animals in your tree or shrub, write about why you think that is.
