What is a food chain?

Answer.....

It is all the living things that depend on each other for food.

Think about a particular food chain and describe what each animal or plant uses for food in that chain.

Answers will vary.....

The chain should start with plants and move on to plant eaters, then meat eaters.

Go to pages 20-21. What happens when humans straighten and clean out a river or clear woodland to plant crops?

Answer.....

The variety of the habitat decreases so fewer plants and animals can live there.

Go to pages 22-23. Design a park that is a good habitat for many living things. Draw a picture of your park and label the

different parts.

Answers will vary.....

Drawings should include some wooded areas and some grassland; a source of water; a variety of landscapes; and a way for people to enjoy the park while leaving some areas more wild.
