In this segment, we are going to learn more about medical drugs and drugs that are not good for you.

You will need to go to pages 20 and 21 of the book. Name three different medicines. Say whether they are used to help balance materials the body lacks or has too much of; change the way that cells work; or kill germs

Answers may include.....

Aspirin: Change the way cells work

Digitalis: balance materials

Hormones: balance materials

Seltzer: balance materials

Antibiotics: kill germs

Penicillin: kill germs

Go to pages 22 and 23 of the book. Name three different harmful drugs and how they cause harm to the body

Answers may include.....

Tobacco/cigarettes: block the lungs from taking in oxygen; stops red blood cells from taking oxygen around the body; stop dirt and germs in the throat from being removed naturally; bronchitis/coughing; chemicals in the smoke cause cancer by making cells grow abnormally

LSD/heroin/cocaine: cause brain damage

Solvents/glue: cause damage to the brain and lungs

Alcohol: can change behaviour and damage the liver and other organs
