Deposit	A long, often curved, deposit of sand formed where the coast turns sharply, or where there is an estuary.
Mudflow	The change in the level of sea during the day.
Sand spit	The settling out of material, such as sand, carried by waves or currents.
Coast	A natural, smoothly-curved inlet in the coast.
Bay	The part of the sea caught by the wind and driven inshore.
Shingle	The rapid movement, as flow of soil, rock and water, down a cliff.
Wave	The place where the land meets the sea.
Tide	A term used for pebbles on the beach.

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
