

# Make a Tudor Rose

The rose was the symbol of the Tudor dynasty. It was a combination of a white rose, the symbol of the house of Lancaster, and a red rose, the symbol of the house of York. When he became king, Henry VII chose this as his symbol in order to illustrate the idea that he was uniting the two main houses of England under his dynasty. Henry VIII used the rose as a symbol of his power and of the unification of England under one leader.
