



How seeds are made

Seeds are made in flowers.

Inside each flower is a dust called pollen.
This is important for making seeds.

When pollen from one plant reaches another plant,
the flower changes and starts to make seeds.

In time, the petals fall away and the seeds grow.

Bees and the wind
carry the pollen from
flower to flower. This
bee is on a dandelion.





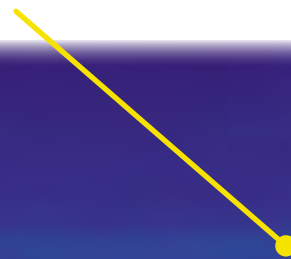

The petals fall off the flower and the seeds grow. In the case of a dandelion the seeds have white tufts on their ends.
