

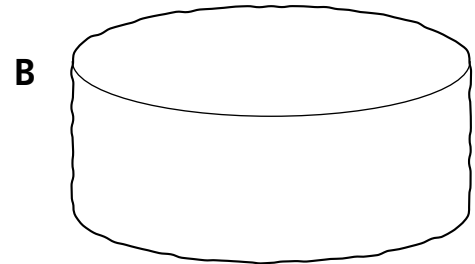
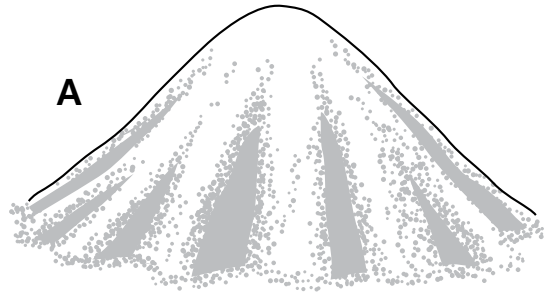

Grains and powders are small pieces of solid. Because they are small, both grains and powders can move more easily.



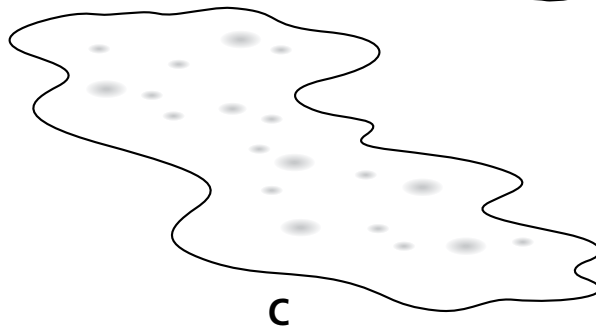
Q1. Give two examples of grains.
