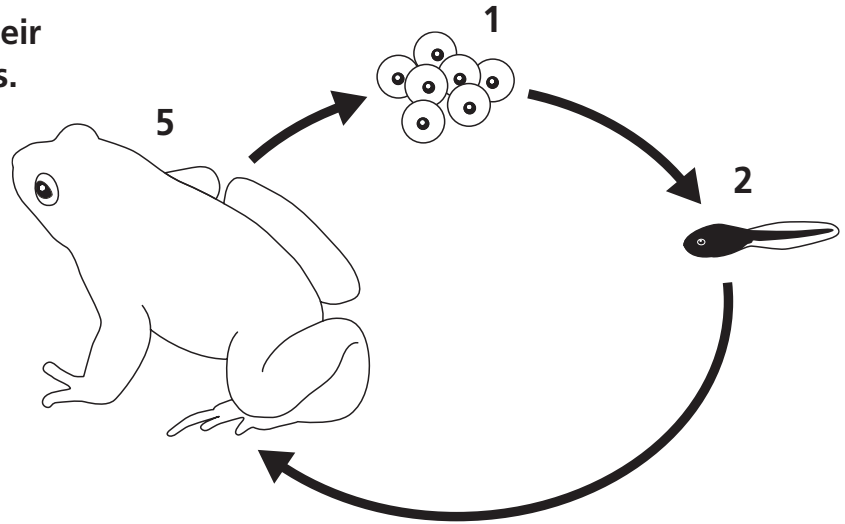


The life cycle of a frog
