- Fixed boundaries: If a question is outside primary learning content, Toby redirects the child to appropriate curriculum material rather than attempting to answer everything. If they ask an inappropriate question, it is not answered.

What makes Toby accurate

- Teacher-authored content: The books, videos and explanations Toby uses are written and produced by Curriculum Visions' own team of experienced teachers and authors.
- Curated resources: Toby searches only within Curriculum Visions' library, so suggestions come from trusted materials created for primary learning.

What Toby does with personal data

- No personal profiling, no personal data collection: Toby does not need children to share personal information to work effectively.
